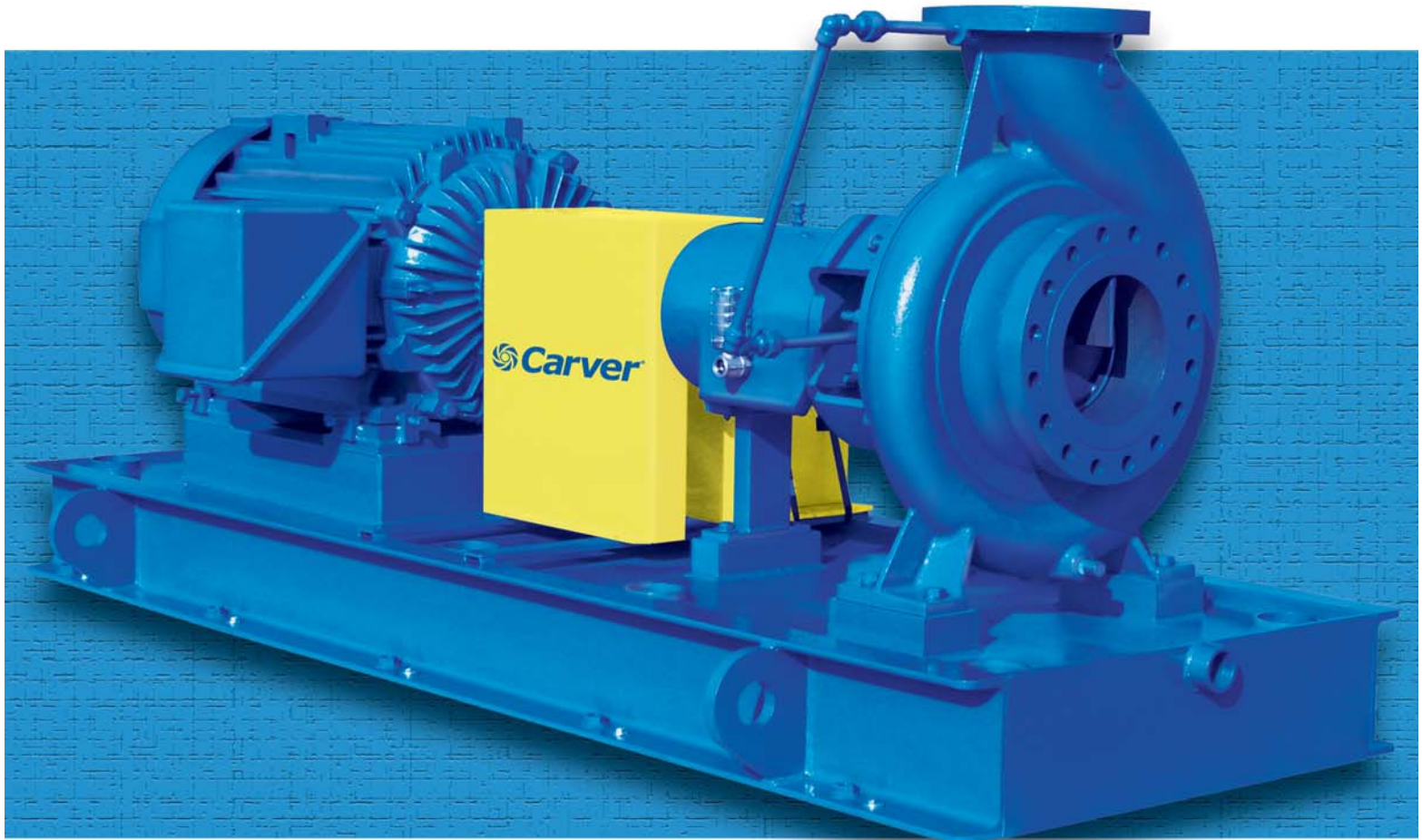

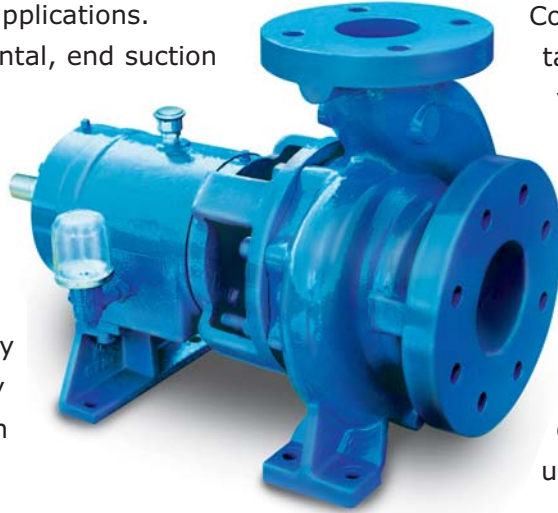

The Process Maxum Series

The Process Maxum is Carver's offering for handling water based solutions and acids used predominately within industrial process applications. Offered as a horizontal, end suction foot mounted unit, the Process Maxum can be motor, engine, or turbine driven. It is a workhorse in the process industry featuring extremely rugged construction and is designed for years of service.



Designed specifically for the needs of the process pump user, hydraulic performance extends to over 9,000 GPM and 720 feet of head. Operating at speeds up to 3,500 RPM, this range is covered by thirty-five sizes available in either Steel/Iron, Steel/316SS, all 316SSS or all D4MCu materials of construction as standard. In addition to these, higher alloys such as Alloy 20, Hastelloy B or C, Monel and Titanium are also available.

As a standard these units include connections for customer supplied vibration and temperature probes.

Common options include double, tandem, and cartridge seals, various seal flush systems, and several bearing lubrication configurations. Heavy duty baseplates, cooling jackets, spacer couplings, and various levels of performance testing are also available, depending on the individual users requirements.

Together, these features combine to produce some of the most efficient hydraulics in the industry and shaft deflection values exceeding that of ANSI B73.1 requirements.

Most importantly, as with all our other pumps, the Process Maxum offers the reliability, low total life cost, and lasting value that has made Carver one of the most trusted names in pumps.

Connections

ANSI 300 lb. flanges with centerline discharge assist in self-venting.

Casing

Back pull out design with registered fits and fully confined gaskets assure sealing and alignment of critical fits. Casing drains included as a standard.

Impellers

Enclosed, high efficiency impellers balanced to ISO 1940, Grade G2.5 for vibration-free operation. All impellers keyed and locked for added safety.

Wear Rings

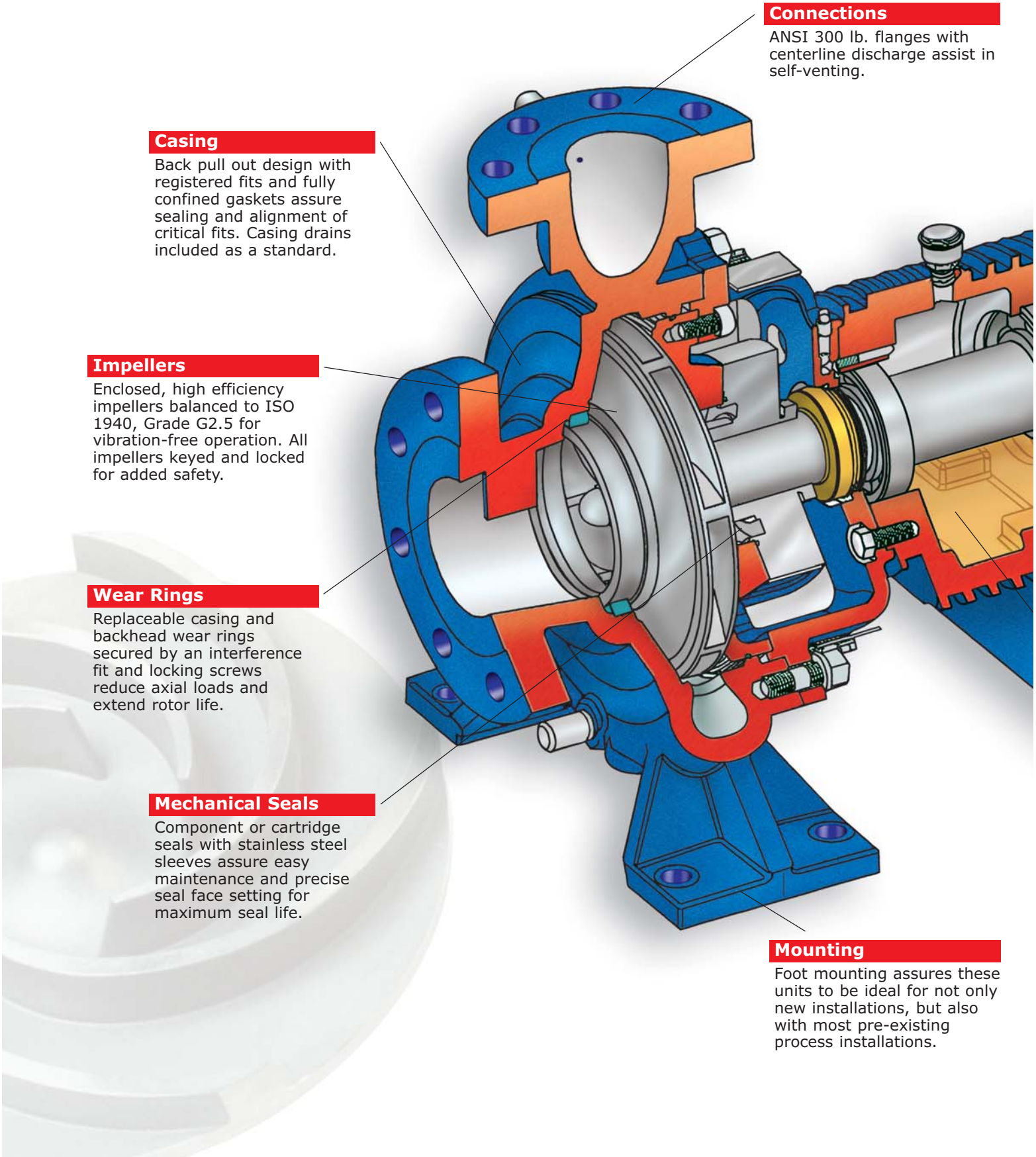
Replaceable casing and backhead wear rings secured by an interference fit and locking screws reduce axial loads and extend rotor life.

Mechanical Seals

Component or cartridge seals with stainless steel sleeves assure easy maintenance and precise seal face setting for maximum seal life.

Mounting

Foot mounting assures these units to be ideal for not only new installations, but also with most pre-existing process installations.





Bearing Frame

Heavy duty bearing housings with labyrinth or magnetic seals keep oil clean for greater bearing life.

Shafts

Large diameter shafts with large fillet radii reduce stress concentrations at cross section changes and keep shaft deflections below 0.001" at the mechanical seal.

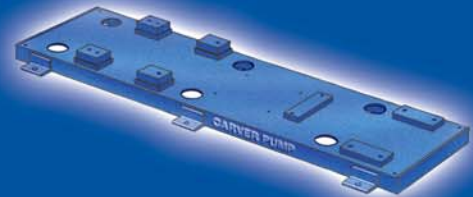
Bearings

Single row, deep groove radial bearings and duplex single row, 40° angular contact thrust bearings mounted back to back for longer component life.

Bearing Lubrication

Oil lubricated bearings with standard oil sump lubrication assure efficient oil feed to all bearings. Conversion to flinger, purge oil mist or pure oil mist are possible without additional machining. For higher temperature applications, additional cooling options are available.

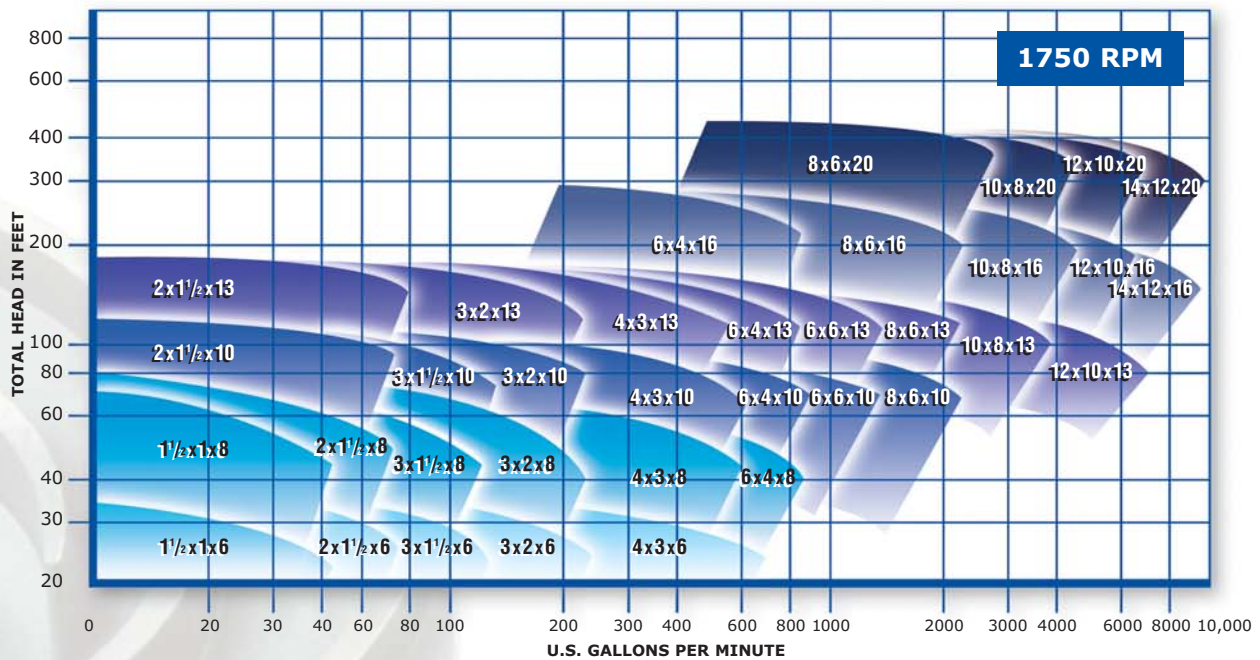
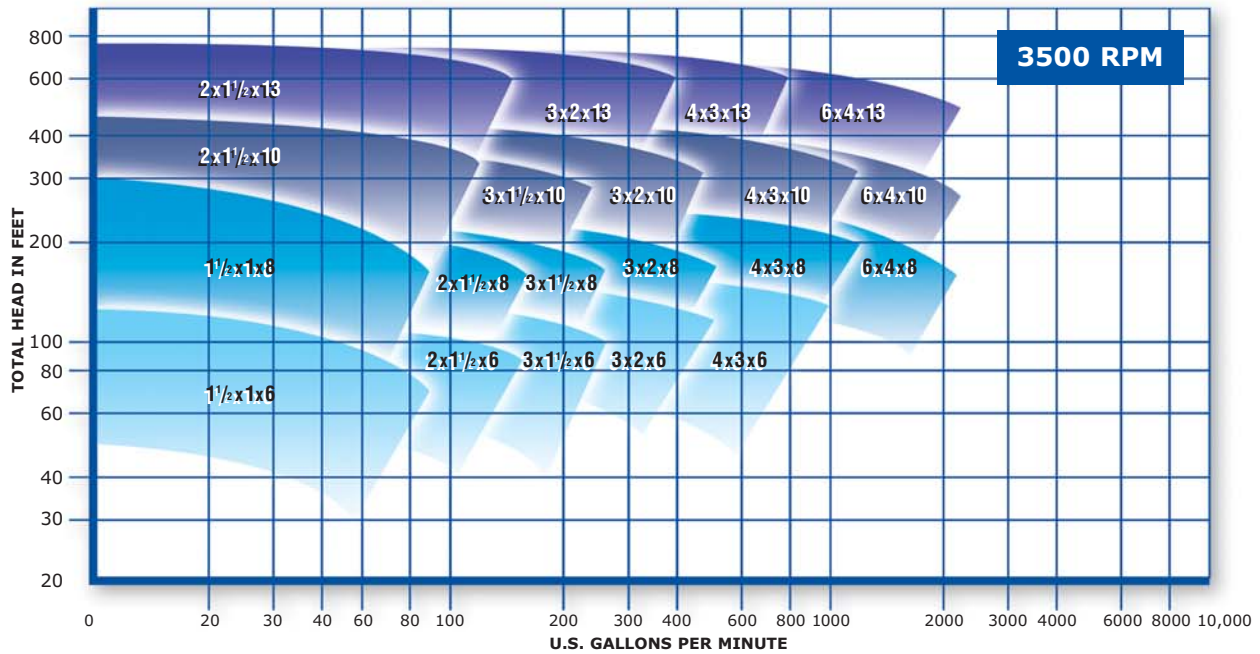
Designed and manufactured by Carver Pump specifically for the Maxum Series, these fabricated baseplates insure a secure mount for your application. Heavy duty in nature, when combined with proper foundation preparation, these bases are a great starting point in making sure your pump/motor combination remain securely mounted.

Fabricated from structural steel for maximum strength, each baseplate includes machined Pump/Motor pads to insure stability and assist during final alignment, plus grout holes in order to allow secure attachment to the foundation. Prior to shipping, each unit is prepped and painted in accordance with our standard procedure for added surface protection.

Additional features are available upon request, such as a recessed sloping deck with drain, additional grout or vent holes, motor alignment screws, leveling jackbolts, integral lifting lugs or specialized surface preparation that may be required when using specific grout or protective surface coatings. Whatever the requirement, Carver Pump can typically customize the baseplate to meet or exceed your expectations!
